ORDER OF THE ARROW



"Alertness to the needs of others is the mark of the Vigil Honor. It calls for the individual with an unusual awareness of the possibilities within each situation.

The Vigil Honor is the highest honor that the Order of the Arrow can bestow upon its members for service to lodge, council, and Scouting. Membership cannot be won by a person's conscious endeavors.

The Vigil Honor is a high mark of distinction and recognition reserved for those Arrowmen who, by reason of exceptional service, personal effort and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions beyond the immediate responsibilities of their position or office to one or more of the following: their lodge, the Order of the Arrow, Scouting, or their Scout camp."

The above paragraphs is how the *Order of the Arrow Handbook* describes the type of Arrowmen who are selected for the Vigil Honor every year by lodges across our nation. It is often said that the Vigil Honor cannot be earned; only bestowed. Under no circumstances should tenure in Scouting or the Order of the Arrow be considered as reason enough for a Vigil Honor recommendation.

Soon, the Na Mokupuni O Lawelawe Lodge Vigil Honor Selection Committee will be conducting its deliberations for the Vigil Class of 2019. The committee needs your help to effectively select this year's class. As our lodge is spread out all across the Pacific, there will be potential Vigil candidates from each chapter that may be unfamiliar to the committee members from the other chapters. In order to ensure that every eligible Arrowman is thoroughly considered by the members of this committee, please submit the name and nomination write-up for any Arrowman you consider worthy of this high honor to the Vigil Honor Selection Committee.

All Brotherhood members whose lodge membership dues are paid for 2019, who are currently registered in Scouting, and who attained their Brotherhood prior to *November 10, 2017*, are eligible and will be considered by the committee. Nominations should be accompanied with a write-up that outlines the scope of service each nominee has given to the lodge, the community, and to Scouting. Please use the attached nomination form.
